But do they really deserve them? Do Brooklinen's sheets feel as good as people say? Let's look into this a little bit. You get a flat and a fitted sheets set along with two pillowcases. The textile is made of Belgian Lin of high quality and is made in Portugal. Comes in White or Cream. Has been stone washed so that it feels lived in from day one. Oeko-Tex certified. Will fit mattresses that have a depth of no more than 12 inches. You'll get the king-sized pillowcase with the Cal King and King packages. 60-day money back guarantee. Advantages: Excellent quality. Wicks away water better than cotton. Good for hot sleepers. Soft to the touch and softens more on laundry. Sustainable. No harmful chemicals used in the manufacturing process. Cons: Your color options are limited to White or Cream. Linen folds a lot. If you return the goods, you are still responsible for shipping and handling. If you've used them before returning them, there's a handling fee of \$9.95 Material/Style The Linen Core sheet is the newest addition to the range. They are made with the same attention to detail. They are made of Belgian Lin and woven in Portugal. The textile is stone washed before leaving, which makes the linen softer to the touch directly. The Brooklinen pillowcase set is made of the same fabric and has the company's standard envelope design. This means no zippers that stick and no pillows make a break for it either. A percale weave has been used to ensure a mixture of usability, feeling, & breathability. The colors have been kept to a simple white and cream so you have a very understated style with this product. Build quality Bedding quality is excellent. The seams are very neat, and the company is definitely trying to live up to its promise of producing quality products at excellent prices. The seams will not be undone in a hurry and, with proper care, these mounted sheets will last for good long time. The fabric feels tense and and and this bodes well for longevity. Percale weave makes for a sturdy fabric that won't begin to crumble after a few washes. The finish is understated and elegant. As Brooklinen puts it, it makes style effort. Durability All natural fibers are subject to some shrinkage, especially with the first washes. What makes these different is the fact that they have already been stonewashed. This means that the shrinkage, if there is any at all, will be kept to a minimum. If you follow proper care instructions, you should not have a massive problem with shrinkage at all. Linen is also a very durable fiber and stands up well to wash and wear. A good set of linen sheets, if they look after correctly, will last you a lifetime. Taking care of your bedding is not a complicated process, it just means that you have to detect treat spills immediately, use a cold wash when washing and, ideally, hang it out on the line. You could use a dryer if you needed to, but would need to use the lowest setting possible. Weight Depending on the type of bedding that you are used to, these are bound to feel a little heavier. It's a higher quality textile, and the fabric used makes it a little thicker as well. It won't crush you, but it's bound to feel heavier than a regular cotton or polycotton one would. What makes this okay is that it breathes very well and doesn't cling to your body, so you won't feel hemmed in or trapped at any stage. Except as, if you decide that this linen is not right for you, you can only return it. All you will be out is shipping and admin fee. Feel and Comfort People are amazed at how soft these mounted sheets are. When you think of linen, you tend to think of sharp fabric that doesn't move well. The stone washing part of the manufacturing process helps to give the sheets a softer, more used feel. They are comfortable from the day you get them and will soften more every time you wash them. When it comes to regulating body temperature, nothing beats natural fibers. Linen was used to make garments in Ancient Egypt for an excellent reason – it makes the skin breathe. These set sheets do the same. As a bonus, the linen has better moisture-wicking properties, and better absorption than cotton does. Price/Value We don't look at the cheapest of the prices here, but the value is outstanding. You get a set of bedding that can easily hold you for the rest of your life. And you have the added incentive that the company guarantees its execution for life as well. This bed linen is a cut above everything else on the market. The fabric is soft and durable and relatively easy to wash. It is an excellent option for warm sleepers or those suffering from night sweats. The color range is somewhat limited but, let's face it, cream and white will go with almost any color scheme. Who's going to buy Brooklinen Sheets? Anyone looking for 100% natural bedding Someone who likes like already broken in. A person who wants to invest in terms of his bed linen. Someone looking for effort style. There is no denying it, this product is easy on the eyes and will never date or go out of style. Warm sleepers are looking for a way to stay cooler at night. The breathability of this product is excellent, and the natural fibers will allow heat to divert naturally from your body. People suffering from night sweats. These sheets are washable and you can, if necessary, whiten them, but they can also be stained quite easily. This is something that you will need to consider. A person who can't stand folds. If this describes you, stay away from this product. All natural fibers are prone to straightening, and this is no exception. Rounding things up – these are more expensive than your standard set of sheets would be. However, they are very durable, feel luxurious and of high quality. They will pay for themselves eventually because they will not have to be replaced as often as would normally be the case. Add in the comfort level, absorption properties, and company lifetime warranty, and you have a real winner here. So, to answer our original question, these sheets live up to the hype.
